

## GLOW IN THE DARK LANTERNS:

Sugar skulls have a very important meaning in Day of the Dead celebrations. They are placed on altars to symbolize the deceased as well as to represent life. The colourful and whimsical designs represent the joy and vitality of life.

### **Materials Needed:**

1. Mason jars
2. Black sharpie
3. Glow in the dark paint (or glow sticks with parental supervision)
4. Small brush

### **Instructions:**

1. Use the black sharpie to paint a fun sugar skull or Calavera design on the front of the mason jar/jars. You can follow the instructions for the balloon activity for this lantern design as well. You can also write the name of your deceased loved one on the forehead of the sugar skull if you desire to.
2. Using the small brush, paint the inside of the jar with the glow in the dark paint (if using glow sticks, break open glow sticks into jar and shake with parental supervision)
3. Once the paint dries, place the lid on the jar
